FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

We will have a special remembrance mass for all those buried from our Church over the past year on Monday, the 2nd of November at 7:00PM. All parishioners are welcomed to attend.

...We've scheduled our annual Mass of the Anointing of the Sick on Saturday 7 November at 11:30AM. All who struggle with illness of body, mind, or spirit can gather in the Church and be anointed with the Oil of the Sick. If you're not able to make it to the Church, please call the Rectory to make arrangements for a priest to come to your house to bring Communion and the Anointing...

...My annual report to the parish on our current financial status is scheduled for the weekend of 7/8 November. I'll be speaking at all the Masses.

...We've been planning for our 100th Anniversary year that begins with the celebration of the Feast of the Epiphany on 2/3 January 2016. That will be **FOUNDERS' DAY**.
